#### **Did You Know?**

- You can recycle pizza boxes and paper plates as long as they don't have grease or food residue spots bigger than your hand.
- Clean aluminum foil is recyclable.
- You can recycle plastic caps and lids by keeping them attached to your plastic containers.
- Plastic bags and Styrofoam are NOT accepted for recycling in the City's blue bins.

## **Why Recycle?**

- Recycling right helps keep our city clean, green and healthy!
- Recycling helps keep alleys clean, which reduces crime, deters illegal dumping and improves public health!
- Recycling creates jobs and boosts our economy! Our local recycling industry contributes \$639 million in St. Louis payroll.
