HAZARDOUS WASTE (Paints [oil-based, acrylic, craft, hobby], stains, varnishes, pesticides, herbicides, poisons, gasoline and other fuels, solvents and strippers, aerosols, motor oil and filters, gas cylinders [BBQ size or smaller], fluorescent tubes, antifreeze, brake and transmission fluid, pool chemicals and other acids and bases, car batteries, wood preservatives, driveway sealant and items containing mercury [thermometers, thermostats and mercuric salts]. Residents can make one drop off per calendar year with the first 50 lb recycled for free and \$1.00/lb thereafter. There is a \$0.20/lb charge for latex paint.)
