### The WGPC Mission Experience Grant

The WGPC Mission Experience Grant was conceived to encourage young adults from Webster Groves Presbyterian Church to support their interest in mission, service and education by participating in volunteer projects, study programs, social action campaigns, unpaid internships and focused travel or mission trips in the spirit of WGPC's mission to serve Christ through active discipleship with our community and in the world.

#### **Grant Program Purpose:**

The purpose of the WGPC Mission Experience Grant is to provide educational, spiritual, and mission discernment through financial support to young adults in the Webster Groves Presbyterian Church community to serve Christ through meaningful contributions to the world around them.

#### **Eligibility:**

- 1. The candidate must meet the following requirements:
  - a. Be a member of WGPC or
  - b. An active participant in WGPC programs or
  - c. Have a connection to WGPC and its ministries
  - d. Applicant is a one-time recipient of this grant
- 2. Young adults include post-high school students aged 19 to 30 for primary consideration.
- 3. Financial grants can be awarded in amounts up to \$2,000 depending on the quality, focus and need of the experience.
- 4. The grant shall be administered by a subcommittee of the Mission Commission and shall include 1 Elder and 2 additional members of WGPC, one of which is serving on the commission. Pastoral review may also be required.
- 5. An interview with the committee is required in person, by phone or by video conference.
- 6. The applicant agrees to an evaluation presentation of their project or service to the WGPC congregation, Mission Commission or Session at the conclusion of their experience.

#### **Project Criteria:**

All proposed projects will be evaluated according to these criteria:

- 1. Compatibility with the mission and philosophy of WGPC in service to Christian values.
- 2. Connection to the people, programs and goals of WGPC.
- 3. The applicant's preparation for, and articulation of, the project and purpose.
- 4. The benefits of the project to the congregation, community or service to the world.
